JANUARY

LINK CAMP: To be held at the scout hall, this is the ideal opportunity for anyone who is interested in joining the troop to complete all their membership requirements in one swoop. Also remember that there is a recruiters badge out there for those who have friends that they introduce to the troop who then become members.

FEBRUARY

ADVENTURE HIKE: To be held in the Magaliesberg Conservancy near Buffelspoort, the scouts will hike up a kloof next to cool refreshing pools which are perfect for swimming, water-cricket or diving into from nearby rocks. Once up the Kloof, scouts will split into their patrols and use their mapping skills in a race to find nearby natural features before spending the night next to a roaring fire and the sounds of nature.

BP SUNDAY AND GALA: To be held at Bishop Bavin School, this event celebrates BP's birthday and also affords the troop to reclaim the swimming trophy from 1st Kengray BK, a trophy which rightfully belongs here!

KONTIKI: To be held at Murray Park in Springs, this event of home-made rafts on a serene lake is a firm favourite with the scouts. Cubs and siblings are also welcome to take part in the beaver challenge on the Saturday. Attended by several thousand scouts each year, this is also an opportunity to network with some of estimated 28 million scouts out there. This year's theme is "Kontiki visits Brownsea Island".

At present, the troop will also be swimming on 8 and 22 February. Younger scouts will be afforded the opportunity to complete their swimmers badges, whilst the older scouts will learn about lifesaving and
