Dear prospective scouts

Scouting is about fun, adventure and forging friendships in the great out-doors. The scouting trail will offer you the chance to go on hikes and camps around the country, jamborees around the world and to do activities such as boating, abseiling, orienteering, paintballing, scuba diving and flying which other boys can only dream of doing.

Scouting is also about becoming something different to your peers at school. When you decide to become a scout, you commit to a scout promise which you will have to try and live up to for the rest of your life. The promise is the most important part of being a scout, and making it commits you several things, including always helping others (even those you don't like), not swearing and always doing your best.

This is a big commitment on your part, and to help you to decide whether or not you want to become a scout we will be running a link camp on 20 and 21 September 2008. On this camp you will learn what it is to be a scout, you will learn some basic scout skills and you will have a great deal of fun in the process. You will also cover all the requirements needed to become a scout or (if you are a cub) to earn your link badge, except for the visits to the troop on Friday evenings (you need to visit the troop at least 3 times before you can become a scout). Please note that one of the requirements of the link badge is that you attend a link camp like this one, so all cubs over the age of 10 ½ who are considering going up to scouts are encouraged to attend, even if they are as yet uncertain as to whether they want to join scouts. The next link camp will probably be held next year.

The camp will take place at the 1st Bedfordview Scout Hall grounds in Disa Road, Bedfordview and will commence at 09h00 on Saturday 20 September. You will have finished the camp by 13h00 on Sunday 21 September.

The cost of the camp is R80,00 per person. This will cover the costs of the camp, including Saturday lunch and dinner, and Sunday breakfast and lunch. Such requests will be kept strictly confidential.

- A campfire blanket (only if you have one)

- A towel
- A bathroom bag (soap, sponge, toothpaste and toothbrush, deodorant etc)
- A notebook and pen/pencil
- A torch
- Any personal medication, together with directions on how to use it
