Re: Buffalo Gorge Hike - 17 to 19 September 2010

Dear scouts and parents

As you will note from your Year Planners, a troop hike is scheduled from the 17th to the 19th of September 2010.

I have made a provisional booking for the Buffalo Gorge trail, located within the Middleburg area. The trail is run by Jacana Trails and is about 20km long, making it ideal for those who want to complete their Pathfinder or Adventurer hikes. More information on the hike and the facilities available on the trail can be obtained from http://www.jacanacollection.co.za/details.aspx?ID=15.

The hike is longer than most troop hikes, owing to the fact that I will be using it to complete my First Class Hike.

The hike is open to all invested scouts and to young men of scout-going age who are interested in scouting. Cubs who are visiting the troop regrettably may not attend the hike due to SASA rules. We will be meeting at the scout hall on the afternoon of Friday 17 September and will return on the afternoon of Sunday 19 September. Full details will be provided closer to the hike.

The cost of the hike itself is roughly R150 per person, which covers the use of the trail and facilities. Petrol costs will vary according to the number of scouts attending, but should be in the region of R70 per person. As such, the cost of the weekend is an estimated R220 per person, which excludes food, which each scout should bring with him. Over the years the troop has made extensive use of Jacana's trails and we have always found the facilities to be excellent and well worth the cost.

If any <u>invested</u> scout is interested in attending the hike but cannot afford the fee, please contact our chairman, Marlou Giannoccaro on 082 457 1820 to seek financial assistance from the Group Committee. Such requests will be treated confidentially and the committee will do their utmost to try and help you. Young men who want to attend the hike but who are not invested can regrettably not approach the committee for assistance.

To keep on track with this goal I would recommend that you all aim to have your Adventurer by the end of September this year. This hike is an ideal opportunity to get going with your advancement and World Jamboree hopefuls are particularly encouraged to attend.

Those scouts who want to log the hike for their Adventurer hike are reminded that you need to complete a Pathfinder hike first. As the Adventurer hike has to be overnight whereas your Pathfinder hike can be a day hike, you are encouraged to do a patrol day hike of at least 10km prior to this hike so that you can make full use of your opportunities.

As the trail needs to be booked with a private company who will require payment upfront, you are asked to RSVP to me by no later than Sunday 12 September 2010 as to whether or not you will be able to attend. If you want to attend, the full amount of R220 should be paid by no later than 12 September 2010. Unless there is a medical or family emergency, this cost will be non-refundable and will be lost should you cancel your attendance after 12 September 2010.

Full details of the hike, including consent forms and final costings will be provided to those scouts confirm that they wish to attend.

Finally, some scouts have borrowed compasses from the troop and not returned them. As these are to be utilised on the hike you are requested to return these to the troop as quickly as possible.
