Re: Year Planner Opinion Poll

Dear scouts and parents

The time has once again for the scouter team to finalise the year planner for next year. This past year has seen a problem with attendance at troop events, and if possible I would like to address this issue before going to the effort of planning events which are not going to be supported by members of the troop.

I would firstly like to check if troop meetings are convenient for members. Scouts are reminded that you are expected to attend 75% of all troop meetings during the year. I do not think this is excessive (one can imagine the fuss if you only attended 75% of school days), but it pays to check that troop meetings suit everyone.

I would also like to check what events appeal to scouts. It is quite disheartening to plan a camp or other scout event only to see it cancelled due to lack of interest. Scouts properly happens at camp, and scouts should be attending several camps each year of they are to get the most out of their scouting experience. In order to run a successful camp one would ideally want at least two patrols worth of scouts attending.

To this end I have prepared a written poll which will hopefully provide the scouter team with meaningful information which will allow for a scout programme which appeals to everyone and which will allow for maximum attendance at scout events. It would be appreciated if everyone could endeavour to fill this out and to return it to me by Monday 13 November 2012.

I have included some notes on the poll to assist you in filling it in. My thanks for taking a few minutes to help us build a better troop.

OPINION POLL EXPLAINED:

Question 1: Simply tell us what type of school you will be attending in 2013.

<u>Question 2:</u> We have had a major problem with camps this year. School sports seem to take up more and more weekends, long weekends (when there is no sport) seem to be family time, and during holidays there are school tours and family vacations. When should we be setting our camps to ensure you are most likely to be able to attend?

<u>Question 3:</u> The scouter team needs a break and so do you, but when should the troop close? You can choose more than one option (eg over December holidays and long weekends). The problem at present is that, normally with the exception of a week or two and the December holidays, there is no overlap between government and 3 term private school holidays. The abysmal attendance in August and September this year simply cannot be repeated. I am not sure if this is an issue with sports or whether the large amount of holidays was the cause of this period of poor attendance, but please let us know when you would like to see the troop closed.
