Pathfinder Camp (1 – 3 February)

The first camp of the year will be taking place at Arrowe Park in Benoni and is basically designed to help get younger members of the troop their Pathfinders.

Although it is impossible to complete ALL the requirements (the camp is only a weekend long and one requirement is that you camp five nights as a scout, for



instance), by the end of the camp you should have received sufficient training to allow you to finish your Pathfinder within the next three months.

Scouts who already have their Pathfinders are welcome to attend the camp as part of the camp staff. As many of the other advancement items require that you train Pathfinder skills, you will also have a good opportunity to advance on this camp.

Link Camp (23 – 24 February)

There are several cubs about to move up to the troop and a camp will be held for them covering all the requirements for membership of the troop. If you have friends who want to join the troop this is an ideal opportunity for them to complete all the membership requirements too in the shortest possible time. This camp will take place at the scout hall and will cost R100 per person attending. If you have friends who want to attend, please let me know by no later than Friday 8 February 2013. Further information will then be sent out.

Kontiki (12 – 14 **April**)

Kontiki will be taking place in April this year at Arrowe Park. The scouters will be taking a more active role in the planning of Kontiki this year to help avoid the difficulties that we experienced in 2012.

Planning for Kontiki has already commenced and I would like to challenge the troop to do well enough to earn an invitation to the Chairman's Challenge. In order to do this we need to know who will be attending Kontiki well in advance. If you can only attend for part of the time, please let me know as well.

I would estimate a cost of R200 per person for the weekend, which will include food, camping fees and a Kontiki badge. It would assist our planning if we could know who will be attending Kontiki. This will allow us to set achievable objectives for the weekend and to allow for the smooth running of the event.

To this end I would ask everyone to RSVP for Kontiki by no later than Friday 1 March 2012. If you could do so sooner that would be great.

Four troop programmes have already been dedicated to Kontiki Prep, so please make sure you attend these. If you have friends who want to join Kontiki, this is a great opportunity for them to learn the skills necessary to put a decent raft on the dam.
