District Competition Camp:

The District Compo Camp will be held at Arrowe Park from 10 to 12 May this year. Last year we managed a third place and I would like to see the troop returning the trophy to its rightful home this year. The theme for this year's camp is "Spud" and the camp promises to be just as full of fun and memories as the books by John Van De Ruit.

The PLs will be carefully scrutinising the troop over the next couple of weeks to see who will receive the honour of being selected to represent the troop at the Compo Camp. Troop Hike:

A provisional booking has been made for the Rooikrans Hiking Trail near Loskop Dam on the weekend of 24 to 26 May 2013.

We will be staying at a well-equipped base camp and will do two day hikes totalling about 26km. Access to the trail is through the Loskop Dam Nature Reserve and a variety of small game species have been recorded in the area. The area offers spectacular bushveld views and should be a couple of degrees warmer than Joburg.

The hike is ideal for those who want to complete either their Pathfinder or Adventurer hikes or for anyone who simply enjoys getting out and enjoying the great out-doors.
