End of Year Camp

Due to the National Senior Scout Adventure no year-end camp was planned for this year. Only two scouts will be attending the National Senior Scout Adventure though and a number of scouts have asked if a year-end camp can be run.

To gauge the interest in such a camp I would ask that all scouts complete the reply slip below and return it to me by 4 November 2016. Details of the year end camp (if any) will be provided shortly thereafter. This form is not a commitment to attend a camp, it is merely an "expression of interest".

With regards the possible venues, please note the following:

Mpumalanga Drakensberg:

200ha farm with numerous small game species located near Lydenberg. Possible activities: Hiking, commando course, swimming, boating, fishing, game drive, visit to Sudwala Caves or Long Tom Pass. Disadvantages – heavy rainfall area, expensive tolls to get to venue, quite far.

Vaal River

Small holding on Vaal river. Possible activities: Hiking, commando course, swimming, boating, tubing down Vaal river, visit to Vredefort dome, fishing, pioneering. Disadvantages – river is low due to drought. Close to home though, pioneering is an option.

Van Reenen

Small farm on Free State side of Van Reenen. Possible activities: Hiking, bushmen paintings, visit to smallest church in the world, visit to Natal battlefields, boating, swimming, fishing. Disadvantage – far away, drought at present so dam very low. In December / Jan expect one can expect rain.
