Onteresting Facts:

• The Group started with ten scouts under the leadership of Edward H Wright, meeting at the Bedfordview Government School;

• The original group colours were royal blue with a red trim. The present colours (fawn with a red trim) were first recorded in 1955;

• The cub pack was established in 1932;

• In 1977 two cub packs were attached to the group – the Klipspringer and Steenbok packs. This continued to the late 1980s / early 1990s;

• The Bedfordview Rover Crew, established in 1977, is the oldest continuously running crew in South Africa;

• The 1st Bedfordview Scout Group is the only Group in South Africa with two active rover crews attached to it – the Bedfordview and the Village Rover Crews;

• His Grace the Duke of Atholl was a member of the Group in his youth;

• The Group has during the course of its history fallen under the Eastern, Germiston and Northrand Districts.
