In addition to cooking up a storm and learning new cooking techniques, large portions of the Scoutcraft Fires and Cooking Badge (junior scouts) and the Cook Badge (senior scouts) will be covered, as will most of the portions of the cooking sections of the new advancement programme (up to First Class level).

If you are working on your First Class Badge you will need to lead a patrol of four junior scouts in a cooking a meal during the camp. Make sure you encourage your juniors to attend or you risk losing out! You will also need to build two "conservation cooking" devises before the camp and demonstrate them on the camp (First Class Living Outdoors Item 3(i)). Make sure you prepare for this!

FRIENDS: If you have friends / potential recruits of scout-going age who

are prepared to follow the Scout Law on the Camp they are welcome to attend. If you are doing your First Class badge and are short numbers why not do some recruiting, you never know, you may end up with a permanent addition to your patrol.

- A duly completed consent form (compulsory, to be handed in at camp)
- Sleeping bag with a pillow and a compact ground mattress
- A rain coat
- A hat (preferably your troop cap)
- Full scout uniform together with a hanger to hang it on. You should arrive and leave the camp in full uniform
- A bathroom kit (comb, toothpaste, toothbrush, soap, face cloth etc). There is a single shower at the scout hall
- A towel
- Insect repellent
- Sun cream
- Lip ice or similar balm
- Any personal medication
- A basic first aid kit
- Comfortable shoes
- A torch with spare batteries
- A mess kit (plate, bowl, mug, knife, fork spoon etc)
- socks
- underpants
- 3 x shirts (if you have a troop shirt please bring this)
- 1 x shorts
- 1 x warm clothing for the evening (both a top and long pants. It can get very nippy in the evening. If rain is forecast it is suggested that you bring two sets of warm clothes with you.
